National Redress Scheme in Queensland

PROVIDING SUPPORT AND RECOGNITION

If you or someone you know experienced sexual abuse as a child in a Queensland institution, including in children's homes, schools, foster care, youth detention centres, missions and dormitories, you may be eligible for redress under the Scheme.

Applications must be made between 1 July 2018 and 30 June 2027

What does the Scheme offer?

THE SCHEME WILL PROVIDE ACCESS TO:

- 1. A Redress payment
- 2. Up to 20 hours of counselling and psychological care (and more if required)
- 3. The option to receive a Direct Personal Response (for example an apology) from the responsible institution

Who can apply for redress under this Scheme?

YOU CAN APPLY IF:

- You experienced sexual abuse when you were a child (under 18 years)
- The abuse happened before 1 July 2018
- An institution was responsible for bringing you into contact with the person who abused you
- You were born before 30 June 2010
- You are an Australian citizen or permanent resident
