Notice of Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)

An EIS for the proposed Ensham Life of Mine Extension Project (the proposed project, hereafter referred to as 'the Project') has been prepared on behalf of the Ensham Joint Venture Partners: Bligh Coal Limited (ACN 010186393), Idemitsu Australia Resources Pty Limited (ACN 010236272), and Bowen Investment (Australia) Pty Limited (ACN 002806831) who are the proponents of the Project. The Project would be located in the western part of the central Bowen Basin approximately 200 kilometres west of Rockhampton and 35 kilometres east of Emerald. The proponents propose to develop the Project to extend the operating life of the existing underground bord and pillar operations at the Ensham Mine by up to nine years to approximately 2037, with underground decommissioning/rehabilitation expected to be completed by 2039. The Project covers an area of approximately 2,737 hectares in an area identified in the EIS as the Project Site commencing from within Mining Lease (ML) 7459, ML 70326, ML 70365 and ML 70366 to an area west of ML 70365 within part of Mineral Development Licence 217 (MLA 700061). The Project would continue to produce thermal coal at current planned production rates of approximately 4.5 million tonnes per annum of run of mine coal. As the Project is a continuation of the existing underground bord and pillar mine operations, existing underground and surface infrastructure located on the existing approved MLs will be utilised and no material surface construction activities are required for the Project.
