Fact Sheet

What is *Get Planning Spaces*?

Sport and Recreation Services seeks to implement better planning and prioritisation of sport and recreation infrastructure across Queensland.

Get Planning Spaces is one of the funding programs that comprise the Queensland Government's *Get in the Game* initiative to support sport and active recreation at the grassroots level.

Get Planning Spaces will provide organisations with funding to develop quality infrastructure planning documents. These will contribute to the evidence base regarding future infrastructure needs for sport and recreation in Queensland.

What funding is available?

Organisations are eligible for funding up to a maximum of \$100,000 (GST exclusive).

Applicants may need to contribute financially towards the total project cost.

What projects are eligible?

Eligible projects include:

- state wide facility planning
- regional recreation planning
- regional sports facility planning
- local sport/recreation planning
- sport and recreation precinct master planning.

Eligible organisations can only be funded for **one** project.

Who can apply?

Organisations eligible to apply are:

- state level sport and recreation organisations or industry peak bodies incorporated under the:
 - *Associations Incorporation Act 1981* (Qld)
 - *Corporations Act 2001* (Cwlth)
 - *Cooperatives Act 1997* (Qld)
 - *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006* (Cwlth)
- local governments constituted under the:
 - *Local Government Act 2009* (Qld)
 - *City of Brisbane Act 2010* (Qld)
 - *Commonwealth Aluminium Corporation Pty Ltd Agreement Act 1957* (Qld).

Organisations must also:

- have met any contractual obligations of projects currently funded by the department.

The department encourages a collaborative approach. Where possible:

- state level organisations that utilise similar facilities are encouraged to develop plans in a collaborative manner
- local governments are encouraged to collaborate with neighbouring local governments to investigate the feasibility of developing a regional strategy.
