## Parking



- **There is no patient parking available on the Burke Street Centre site**
- Parking for able-bodied patients is available at nearby multi-storey car parks, close to the main hospital building. Patients with appointments are asked to arrive at least 20 minutes early to allow time to park. The Burke Street Centre is within walking distance from both car parks. - There is limited parking on site for disabled patients with Queensland Transport Disabled Parking Permits. Proceed to the boom gate, press button on the intercom which connects to security. Security will open boom gate. **Only park in disabled spot, must display permit on dashboard.**



- There is a free shuttle bus service between the Princess Alexandra Hospital main building and the Burke Street Centre should you need it. This is unable to cater for small children who need a car or booster seat. 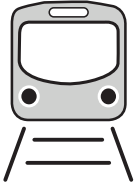

## Public transport



- **Bus:** The Burke Street Centre is within walking distance of the PA Hospital Busway station. 139 and 209. There is also a bus stop on Ipswich Road, across the road from the PA Hospital main building. Regular outbound routes from the city along Ipswich Road include: 113, 115, 117, 124, 125, 172 and 475.

## Public transport



- **Train:** From Park Road railway station the Beenleigh line, turn right up the pedestrian laneway, then right down Burke Street past industrial buildings. ### Taxi

There is a free taxi phone in the foyer of the Burke Street Centre.



### Ambulance

Patients entitled to Queensland Ambulance Service's transport service are still able to use this service to travel to Burke Street.



### Meals

There is no cafe on site. A vending machine is available on the ground floor to purchase snacks and drinks. A cafe is located up on Burke Street within a 5 minute walk.



### Pathology

You may continue to use the pathology services in the Princess Alexandra Hospital main hospital building before your appointment. Otherwise, there is a pathology service located at the Burke Street Centre after 8am weekdays.



### Smoking

There is no smoking on any Queensland Health premises, including the Burke Street Centre.
