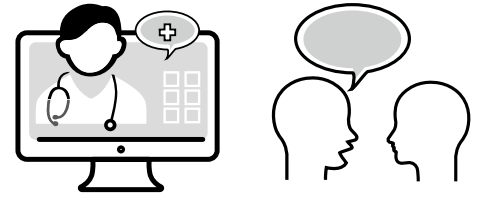


Mental Health

What is mental health

The treating team do not always know the private circumstances and feelings of all patients and families, so please reach out. The most important thing to know is that compassionate, effective and professional support is available right now.

- Mental wellbeing can shift around for many reasons. Emotions and feelings connected with organ donation, transplantation, trauma, grief, relationship and family matters, money concerns, housing, sickness, treatments and other worries – can all affect mental health.
- Hospital, community and online resources, counselling and supports are readily available to help all patients, families and carers at any time. This help is caring, comforting and supportive.
- Being open to support can make the world of difference.
