1 Introduction to Macropods Online

The Department of Environment and Science has a user-friendly digital platform for managing macropod services allowing macropod licence holders to apply for licences, pay fees, and order tags.

The digital return book feature on Macropods Online makes it easier for harvesters and dealers to comply with their record keeping obligations. And submitting returns is also faster and easier allowing users to view and complete their tasks online as simple transactions.

2 Have you registered for an online account?

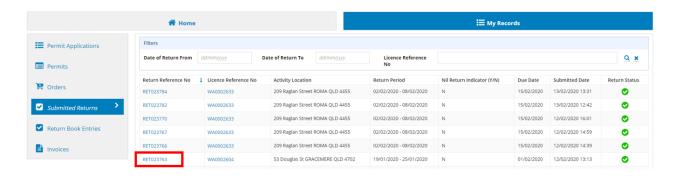

3 How to amend a submitted return

You must request permission to amend a non-nil return you have previously submitted. If your request is accepted, you will be able to make changes to the return line items and resubmit that return.

Go to MY RECORDS > SUBMITTED RETURNS

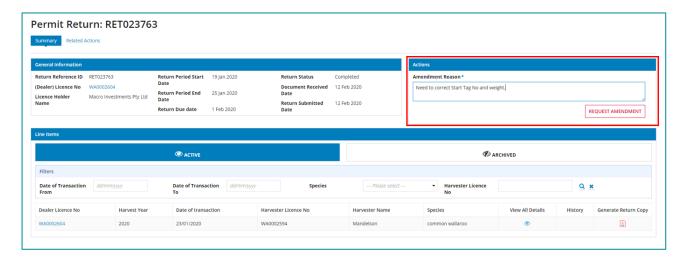
Click on the **Return Reference No** hyperlink for the return to be amended.



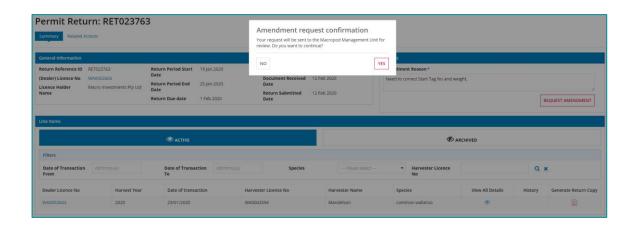
In the detailed view for that return, enter the reason for that amendment in the **Amendment Reason** box.

Please note: The Date of Transaction (for dealer returns) and Date Taken (for Harvester returns) cannot be modified.

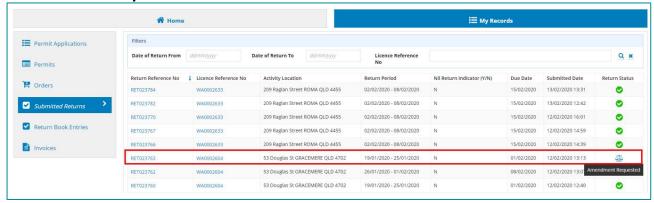
Click the **Request Amendment** button.



Click **YES** in the Amendment Request Confirmation pop-up box.



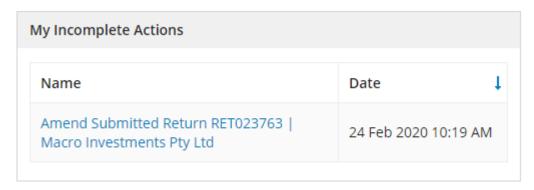
Under **My Records > Submitted Returns** you can now see the status for the return as 'Amendment Requested'



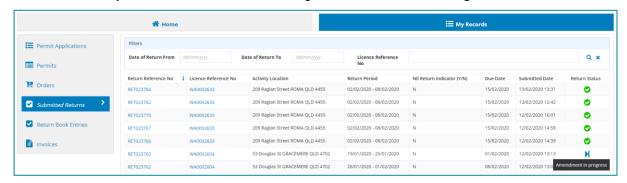
The Submitted Return record now has a Status of "Amendment Requested".

4 Amend submitted return

If your request to amend a submitted return is approved, then you will see an **Amend Submitted Return RET999999** | <**Holder Name>** incomplete action in your *My Incomplete Actions* grid.

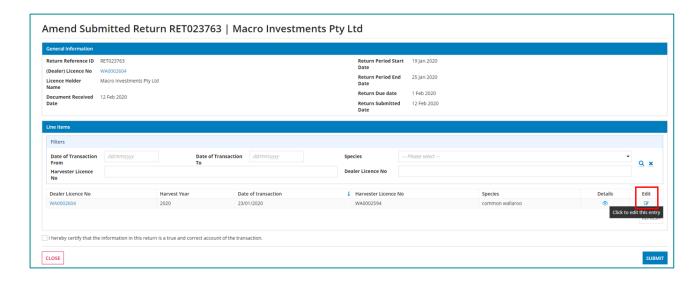


And the status of your Submitted Return will change to "Amendment in Progress".

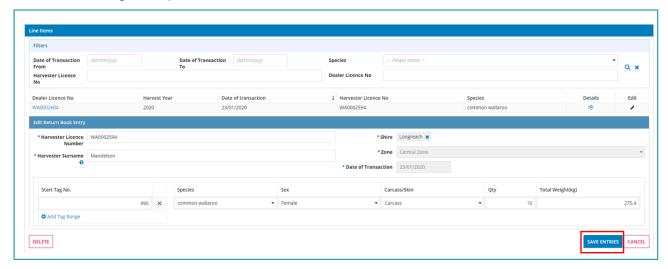


Click on the **Amend Submitted Return RET999999** | **<Holder Name>** incomplete action to make the required changes. Until you make the amendments and re-submit the return, your submitted return will appear with status *Amendment in Progress*.

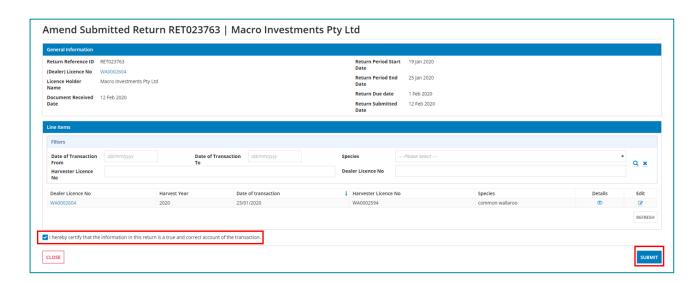
Click on the **Edit** icon for the return line entry you want to change or delete.



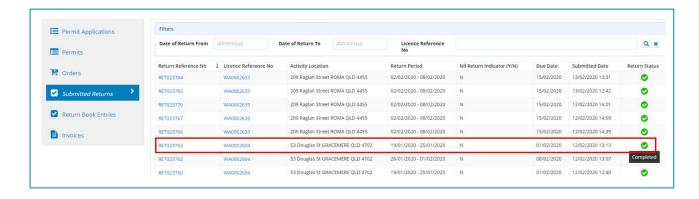
Make the changes required and click **Saved Entries**.



Tick the *submitter's declaration* again and click the *Submit* button to re-submit the return.



The status of the re-submitted return is again "Completed".



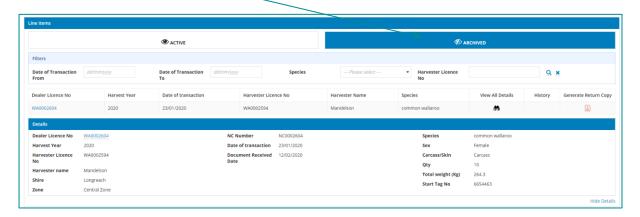
5 How to view all changes and deletions on returns

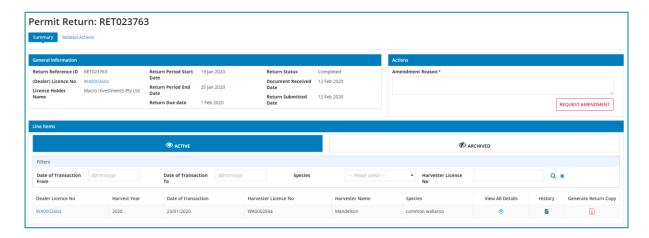
Go to My Records > Submitted Returns

Click on return you want to view

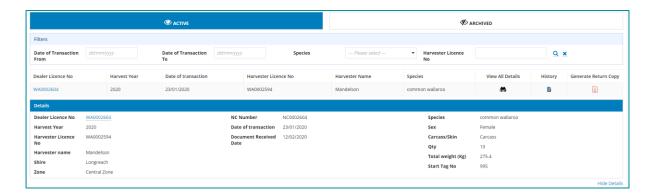
All return changes and deletions will be displayed in the *History* details and on the **ARCHIVED** tab.

The archived tab is shown here:

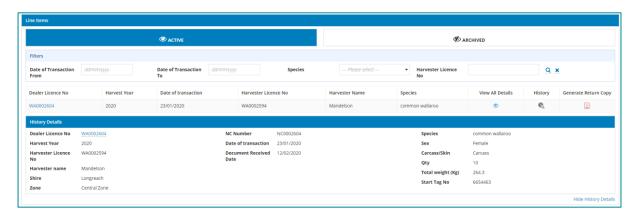




Clicking on View All Details will displayed the amended details for the line item.



Clicking on *History* will display the original details for the line item which was amended.

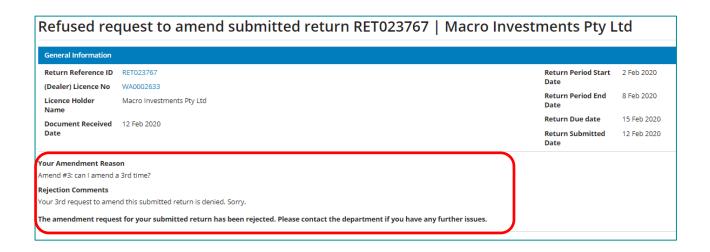


6 Refused request to amend a submitted return

If your request to amend a submitted return is refused, you will get a message saying 'Refused request to amend submitted return RETxxxxxx'



You will be able to view the reason the request to amend a submitted return was refused and close the task.
