



Review of Local Government Decision

Stock Route Management Act 2002

For stock route agistment permits and stock route travel permits, the Department of Resources (the department) can be asked to review a local government's decision to:

- refuse to issue the relevant permit; or
- refuse to renew a stock route agistment permit; or
- impose conditions on the permit; or
- refuse to amend conditions on the permit as requested by the permit holder; or
- cancel the permit.

This form should be received by the department at the address below within 28 days of receiving the local government's decision. You should receive notice of the outcome of the review within seven days for a stock route travel permit, and 14 days for a stock route agistment permit.
