Places on these maps were named many years ago and some are considered offensive and are unacceptable today. We apologise for any offence reading such language might cause.

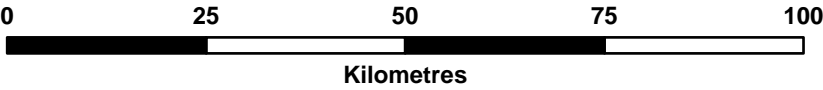

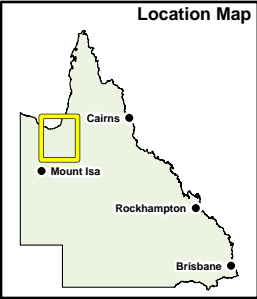
