Queensland Community Support Scheme (QCSS)



The Queensland Community Support Scheme (QCSS) can help people to continue living safely in their home and actively take part in the community.

Eligibility

You may be eligible for the QCSS if you are under 65 years old, or under 50 years old for Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people with:

- A disability and are not eligible for the National Disability Insurance Scheme
- Chronic illness, mental health or other condition, or
- Other circumstances that affect your ability to live independently in the community
