End note 1

To be eligible a person must meet the requirements of A, and B (if any).

A. The person must be either:

- an Aboriginal person
- the spouse of an Aboriginal person
- the former spouse of an Aboriginal person
- the spouse of an Aboriginal person who is deceased
- the former spouse of an Aboriginal person who is deceased
- a Torres Strait Islander
- the spouse of a Torres Strait Islander
- the former spouse of a Torres Strait Islander
- the spouse of a Torres Strait Islander who is deceased
- the former spouse of a Torres Strait Islander who is deceased

B. The person must also meet any additional criteria for participating in the allocation process for available land set out in the trustee's freehold policy.

Examples:

- registered sublease, including a registered sublease of a townsite lease
- residential tenancy agreement for a social housing dwelling situated on the available land
