Queensland Organics Strategy 2022–2032

The Queensland Government has launched the [Queensland Organics Strategy 2022–2032](#) (the Strategy), which outlines how we plan to improve the management of organic materials over the next ten years.

After extensive consultation, the Strategy takes a paddock-to-plate approach that includes the entire organics supply and consumption chain to ensure that we make the most of this important and valuable resource.

The Strategy is supported by the [Organics Action Plan](#) which details how government, community, councils and business and industry will work together to reduce the amount of organic material that is generated and subsequently disposed to landfill.

We've also committed to a ten-year \$2.1 billion waste and resource recovery package, including a \$1 billion Recycling and Jobs Fund. Funding will be available to help reduce organic waste and food insecurity in Queensland, while improving investment opportunities to better recover, reprocess and recycle organic material and divert it from landfill.

By the end of the decade, we aim to:

- halve the amount of food waste we generate
- divert 80 per cent of our organic material from landfill
- recycle at least 70 per cent of our organic material.
