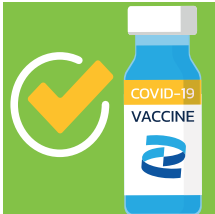


COVID-19 vaccine

Giving your permission



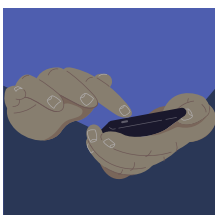
You need to give permission to get vaccinated by signing a form (consent form).



You can ask for an interpreter to help you ask questions and understand what the consent form says. It's your right and it's free.



The consent form is on the internet. You can sign it and bring it to your appointment. You can also sign it at the clinic. Staff will ask if you give permission to have the vaccine.



Scan the QR code for information in your language



- Call 134 COVID (**that is call 13 42 68**) if you have any questions about the vaccine program. You can call 24 hours, every day. Ask for an interpreter if you need one.
- Or, call the Translating and Interpreting Service on **13 14 50** who can connect you to any national health service.



Ask for an interpreter if you need one.



You can bring a support person or carer with you.
