Home Ownership lessee obligations

The following information is to alert you to important obligations associated with a Home Ownership lease for private residential purposes. You should read this section carefully and tick each box once you understand the information. Additional obligations will also apply according to the provisions of the lease.

- The lease will be for a term of 99 years, however you may apply in writing, to the Lessor to renew the lease for a further term before the lease expires. The lessor may decide not to renew the lease only if satisfied the land is not being used for private residential purposes.
- You will be required to pay an up-front lump-sum for lease of the land and purchase of the dwelling (if you didn't construct it) before the lease can be granted.
- If a dwelling does not exist you must build an approved dwelling within 8 years of the start of the lease.
- You may be required to undertake additional actions, such as the negotiation of an Indigenous Land Use Agreement or survey of the land proposed to be leased, before the lease is granted.
- Costs associated with the lease application, such as mortgage registration fees, negotiating an Indigenous Land Use Agreement or surveying the lease area, are the responsibility of the applicant.
- You must comply with the conditions of the lease or the lease could be forfeited.

- Your EOI will not be considered properly made unless all parts of this form are completed fully and correctly. If the form is not completed properly it will be returned to you for completion.
- All applications will be processed having regard to the requirements of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* and related legislation as amended from time to time.
- Information in this form is collected to process and assess your EOI under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*. The consideration of your application may involve consultation with another party and, if so, information in your application may be disclosed to that party.
- You may need to provide evidence of your eligibility for this lease.
- Before submitting your EOI you must read and confirm you understand the lessee obligations.
