
# Disaster Event – South East Queensland Low, May 2009



## **Event Timing and Location –**

A strong upper level low located over south-east Queensland produced damaging winds, high rainfalls, flash flooding and abnormally high tides in May 2009.

#### Assistance Activated -

The Minister for Police, Corrective Services and Emergency Services, The Honourable Neil Roberts MP activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).
