
Disaster Event –South East Queensland East Coast Low 27 December 2007 – 7 January 2008



Event Timing and Location -

High winds and torrential rain commencing in the period from 27 December 2007-7 January 2008, caused coastal erosion and wide spread flooding in South East Queensland. Significant damage has been reported in ten shires to date.

Assistance Activated -

The Acting Minister for Emergency Services, The Honourable Andrew Fraser MP activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).

- Restoration of Essential Public Assets:
- Counter Disaster Operations;
- Disaster Relief Assistance Scheme
- Concessional Loans to Primary Producers
- Concessional Loans to Small Businesses
- Freight Subsidies to Primary Producers
