
Disaster Event - South East and North Coast Queensland East Coast Low, August 2007



Event Timing and Location -

From Wednesday 22 August 2007, a complex low pressure system located over the southeast Coral Sea produced damaging winds, heavy rain and major flooding. This resulted in damage to roads and infrastructure impacting communities in the South East and North Coast Queensland areas.

Assistance Activated – The Minister for Emergency Services activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA) for the South East and North Coast Queensland East Coast Low, August 2007.

- Restoration of Essential Public Assets:
- Counter Disaster Operations;
- Concessional Loans to Primary Producers;
- Freight Subsidies to Primary Producers;
